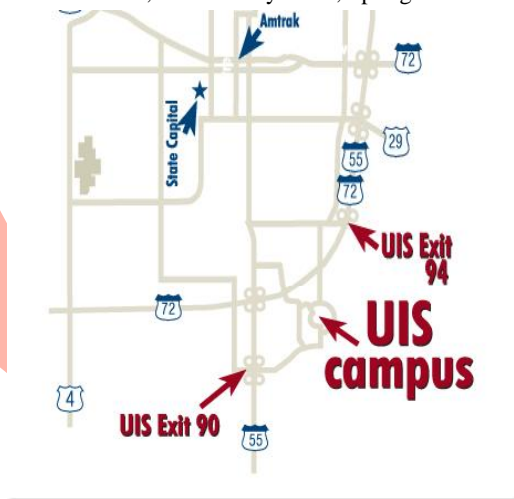

From the North – via I-55

Take Exit #94, Stevenson Dr, turn R at top of ramp, turn L at stoplight to West Lake Dr, go to north edge of campus. Turn R at Edgar Lee Masters Dr, turn L at stop sign to Ernest Hemingway Dr. Go to stop sign to Eliza Farnham Dr, turn R towards Parking Lot D. Enter PAC thru lower circular drive entrance, nearest flagpoles.

From the South – via I-55

Take Exit #90, Toronto Rd. Turn R at top of ramp, go thru small business area, over rail crossing, follow curving roadway past Capital Area Career Cntr. Turn L on 11th St, turn R on Vachel Lindsay Dr, turn L at stop sign. Parking Lot D is on left. Enter PAC as stated above.

From the East – via I-72

At intersection with I-55, take I-55 South, following it to Exit #94, Stevenson Dr. Turn R at top of ramp, follow instructions above from North.

From the West – via I-72

From I-72 take Exit 97A, onto I-55 South. Take Exit 90, Toronto Rd. Turn at top of ramp, go thru small business area, follow instructions above from South.
