



Dramatic changes are in store for more than **1 million Medicaid** and All Kids (formerly KidCare) recipients:

Beginning December 1, 2006, recipients living in Cook and Collar Counties will be required to choose a Primary Care Provider (PCP) as part of the shift to the new **Primary Care Case Management** (PCCM) system, called Illinois Health Connect.

It is important that you know about these changes and become familiar with the new PCCM and Disease Management programs, so that you can help guide and inform families during this time of transition.
