HUD encourages interested individuals to attend this training session, which will cover the following topics:

- Hold Harmless Reallocation changes
- A brief discussion of the rating criteria found in the SuperNOFA
- A discussion of the Supportive Housing Program
- A discussion on the technical submission requirements for new projects
- Answers to any questions
