We will review the specific rights of homeless youth and families under the McKinney-Vento Act. This 2 hour workshop will include information regarding homeless student's access to programs and services, transportation arrangements, choice of schools, waiver of fees and free breakfast/lunch programs and access to preschool programs.

Many homeless families are not aware that their children must be immediately enrolled even without proof of residency and other documents normally required by schools. Parent information will be distributed that you may share with families. Additionally, this workshop will address how to navigate through the educational system to ensure that your clients are receiving the services provided to them under both Illinois and federal law.
